Finding Scientific Literature

You can find all our scientific literature in our Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) - on and off campus.



Open Access Collections

Fetch books and journals from open shelves at the following locations:

Main Library (Bldg 35/200):

Holds scientific literature from all fields, plus textbooks, newspapers and periodicals.

Special Collections (Bldg 33/100):

Specialises on scientific literature about military matters, security and military policy, military and contemporary history. Also holds large sized maps and atlases.

Stack Collections

Using the OPAC, you can request books and journals from our stacks. They will be made available for you in 24 hours or less.



Electronic Media

Besides books and journals in print you will also find electronic media (ebooks, ejournals, databases) in the OPAC. You have access from within the library. For university members access is possible on and off campus, among others via Windows Terminal Service (WTS), provided by the Computing Centre (Rechenzentrum). Nonmembers please ask at the information desk.

Interlibrary Loan

With this service we can provide books and articles for you from partner libraries, if we do not have them among our collections.

Borrower's Card

If you want to borrow books etc. you need a borrower's card. You can get one at the Service Desk of the University Library on Level 0 of Bldg 35/200. Non-members need a Director's permit. Please ask at the information desk.
